
Learning Objectives

- Baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 10.50
- Open to all academic streams: Arts and Languages, Natural Sciences, Mathematics, and Economics
- Application processed through the university presidency
- Required documents: proof of academic qualifications and language proficiency
- Upon registration: issuance of university ID card and official enrollment certificate
- Annual tuition: 1700 Euro
