Bachelor's in Wakf Management

✓ **Program Overview**

The Bachelor's degree program in Waqf Management offers specialized training that combines Sharia sciences and management sciences. It opens broad prospects for developing alternative mechanisms to achieve sustainable development by graduating specialists in the management and administration of modern Waqf institutions.

 - **Objectives of the Program**

This program is designed to achieve the following core objectives:

- ✓ Preparing specialized cadres in the management and administration of institutions.
- ✓ Developing students' academic skills to enable them to pursue postgraduate studies.
- ✓ Providing students with in-depth knowledge of Waqf institutions, the management of Zakat funds and institutions, human resource management, and management control, in addition to further knowledge in data analysis.
- ✓ Deepening students' Sharia education in the jurisprudence of financial transactions and the jurisprudence of Waqf.
 - <u>Pathways to Other Specializations?</u>

The training in Waqf Management allows beneficiary students to orient themselves towards other specializations within the Department of Management Sciences at the Bachelor's level. External students with comparable training can also be directed to this specialization, for example, those coming from higher education institutions/private schools under supervision with a similar specialization.

Furthermore, it qualifies students to pursue Master's level studies in the Waqf Management Master's program or in various specializations within the Department of Management Sciences.

• <u>Teaching Methods:</u>

- ✓ Theoretical lectures and applied case studies in each taught subject.
- ✓ Practical training in financial data analysis using specialized software.





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- ✓ Research projects on Waqfs and their applications.
- ✓ Assessment includes directed work (40%) + final examinations (60%).

✓ <u>Curriculum Highlights:</u>

The Bachelor's degree program in Waqf Management consists of two years of common core studies: the first year as a common core in Economic Sciences, Management Sciences, and Commercial Sciences, and the second year in the Department of Management Sciences. The specialization year includes two semesters:

Fifth Semester:

- Core Courses: Waqf Management 1, Management of Zakat Funds and Institutions, Project Management, and Human Resource Management.
- Methodological Courses: fiqh of Financial Transactions and Economics of Waqf and Development.
- *** Exploratory Course**: Law of waqfs .
- Cross-Disciplinary Course: Specialized Foreign Language (English).

Sixth Semester :

- Core Courses: Waqf Management 2, Islamic Banking, Total Quality Management, and Management Control.
- * Methodological Course: Jurisprudence of Waqf and the Graduation Project.
- **Exploratory Course**: Data Analysis.
- Cross-Disciplinary Course: Specialized Foreign Language (English).

✓ Admission Requirements :

Enrollment in the program requires meeting the following conditions:

- ✓ Baccalaureate certificate (or its international equivalent).
- ✓ Proficiency in Arabic, as it is the primary language of instruction. Arabic language training programs are provided for non-native speakers to ensure their academic readiness.
